### Flash: Project 1 –Slideshow



#### Instructions:

Your task is to create a ten (10) frame themed slide show with Flash.

Create one layer for each slide or picture and have it enter and leave the stage by using a motion tween. Use transformations (position, rotation, scale, easing) and music to create the show. Have text credits either at the beginning and the end. Use blank frames to create time between slides.

When you bring pictures into your show make sure you remove the white backgrounds. You do this by going to PHOTOSHOP and selecting the background and deleting (you should see the checkerboard pattern indicating transparency). Save the file as a .GIF or .PNG file.

In the timeline, there should be a layer for each picture that you use. You create a keyframe at the frame you want the picture to appear. There should be a separate layer for sound and separate layers for text effects.

All of the pictures you use in the slideshow should be imported to the LIBRARY by going to the FILE menu and IMPORT and then IMPORT TO LIBRARY.

The slide show must have some sound effects. If you want to use your own sounds or music, burn the sound(s), music to a disc/USB drive in mp3 or wav format and bring it to school. We can put the sound on the network and you can use the sound/music in your slide show. Use the program Audacity to cut pieces out of your song or change the song by using special effects. You can combine a song with sound effects but you should use 2 sound layers.

Make sure you STREAM the sound. Click on a frame with sound and go to the properties menu and choose STREAM instead of EVENT.
